This is in follow-up to our brief telephone conversation yesterday when I informed you that I have recently been retained by Matin Moghadam, a neighboring property owner to the Chevron #9-7127 LOP site. Mr. Moghadam has retained me to advise him with regard to potential contamination impacts on his property from the Chevron #9-7127 site. As you may know, some of the monitoring wells are located on his adjoining property. It is my understanding that Mr. Moghadam has been provided with very little documentation by Chevron of the work that has done on his property over the years.

I see from the documents on the GeoTracker and ACHCS LUFT/LOP websites that by letter dated June 27, 2012 the ACHCS issued a Notice to Comply to Chevron Corporation, Mr. Onsori Ardavan and Carmazzo Land Co, Inc et al. The response from Chevron submitted on September 17 submits an Additional Site Assessment Work Plan, but not the FS/CAP requested by ACHCS. I will be looking at these documents with my client. Please copy my client and myself on further communications with Chevron on this matter.

Thank you for your work on this case, and I will be in further communication with you regarding this site.
