Hello Jerry,

I just left you a voice message regarding the Chiu Property at 800 Franklin Street. In the ACEH letter dated August 9, 2010, ACEH concurred with CRA's Site Conceptual Model Report recommendations to do further assessment of the down-gradient extent of the plume and to prepare a work plan, which we are close to finalizing.

CRA also concluded that the lateral and vertical extent of hydrocarbon impacted soil is not fully defined in the vicinity of the former USTs along Eighth Street. However, based on the lack of any identified exposure pathways, CRA recommended that no further assessment of hydrocarbon impacted soil is warranted at this time. Looking forward to eventual Site closure, do you feel this is something that will need to be addressed, and should be considered for inclusion in this work plan?

Please give me a call to discuss before the work plan submittal due date of October 12, 2010.
