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Hanson Buys Four, Sells One

Hanson recently made four acquisitions for \$178 million. The company bought three companies near San Francisco: Mission Valley Rock Co., Berkeley Ready Mix Co. and Berkeley Asphalt Co. Hanson says Mission Valley produces 2 million tons per year and has 60 years of permitted reserves, some of the largest reserves in that area. Hanson also acquired Sherman Pipe, a concrete pipe and pre-cast concrete products business. Sherman Pipe has six plants in Alabama and four plants in Georgia that combined produced 630,000 tons of concrete pipe and products in 2004. Hanson sold its 50% interest in Campbell Concrete and Materials, a ready-mixed concrete business in Houston, to Lehigh Cement Co. "The three acquisitions in California are an excellent fit with our existing operations and include valuable long-term aggregates reserves in a market we know well," says Hanson CEO Alan Murray. "The Campbell's disposal completes our withdrawal from ready-mixed concrete in Texas." This year Hanson has spent \$533 million on acquisitions.

Knife River Buys Seven Oregon Companies

MDU Resources Group acquired Jefferson State Redi-Mix Inc., Concrete Products Industries Inc., Jefferson State Asphalt Inc., Cherry Creek Aggregate Inc., Allied Concrete Pumping Inc., Keith Hamilton Trucking Inc., and HDP Leasing Inc. with cash and MDU Resources common stock. The companies have been merged into Knife River Corp., the construction materials and mining subsidiary of MDU Resources. Financial details of the merger were not disclosed. The privately held companies have headquarters in Klamath Falls, Ore. and primarily serve the Klamath Falls market. The companies have a collective annual revenue of about \$6 million. "Jefferson State and its associated companies are a good fit with our existing operations in southern Oregon and the surrounding states," says Bob Vaughn, Southern Oregon Region manager for Knife River.

Vulcan Buys Georgia Quarry

Vuican Materials Co. acquired the Long Branch Quarry in Lumpkin County, Ga. The quarry is located near Dahlonega, northeast of Atlanta. It will be operated by Vulcan's Southeast Division, which has its headquarters in Atlanta. Terms of the transaction were not disclosed. "This acquisition enables Vuican to serve a new high-growth corridor in the greater Atlanta metro area," says Don James, Vulcan's chairman and CEO. "The Long Branch Quarry serves a strong market with excellent potential for long-term growth due to its proximity to Georgia Highway 400 and Lake Lanier."

Lafarge Boosts Gypsum Capacity

Lafarge Group intends to grow its gypsum business by increasing production capacity. Lafarge will expand its production capacity by more than 20% over the next two years. Worldwide, this expansion will total \$367 million and boost capacity by more than 200 million cubic meters. In the United States, Lafarge North America recently started work on modernizing and doubling the capacity of its Buchanan, N.Y. plant, to 60 million cubic meters. This investment of close to \$75 million, together with the division's state-of-the-art plants at Palatka, Fla., and Silver Grove, Ky., will consolidate Lafarge's position as a market leader.
