Closure Solutions, Inc. (Closure Solutions) has prepared this letter to notify you of our intent to proceed with the proposed scope of work as described in the November 13, 2009 *Soil Vapor Testing and Additional Assessment Work Plan* (work plan). Based on telephone and email correspondence, you indicated that while it is your intent to approve the work plan you are unable to do so at this time due to your case review workload associated with SWRCB Resolution 2009-42. Closure Solutions believes that the scope of work defined in the work plan is reasonable and necessary to progress the site toward closure as it addresses known data gaps necessary to complete the closure review process.

Closure Solutions intends to proceed with the proposed scope of work pursuant to CCR Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Section 2722(e) which states "Implementation of the workplan may begin sixty (60) calendar days after submittal, unless the responsible party is otherwise directed in writing by the regulatory agency." Unless Closure Solutions receives notification from your office prior to May 28, 2010 it will be assumed that the Alameda County Environmental Health Department concurs that the scope of work proposed in the work plan is reasonable and necessary.
