Hello Jerry, Alameda County GSA is considering excavating soil from an adjacent area on the HARD property where parking lot construction will be performed during construction of the youth center. The approximate area is shown on the attached site map. Excavation to a depth of approximately 3 feet is anticipated to help reduce the potential for construction workers to encounter soil with residual COCs during construction.

The additional area is within the area of the HARD property previously excavated to a depth of approximately 1 foot for the prior cleanup activities, so the new excavation would be more for soil management purposes. Would you want to see verification soil samples from this area after the excavation? In addition, would you need to see an addendum to the soil excavation work plan?
