Clearwater Group (Clearwater) proposes a modification to the June 5, 2006, Workplan Addendum. The Workplan Addendum was prepared by Clearwater in response to technical comments regarding the document entitled "Work Plan: Additional Subsurface Investigation Groundwater Monitoring Well Installation" dated March 3, 2003, by Environmental Bio-Systems, Inc., Mill Valley, California.

Specifically, Clearwater requests that soil borings SC54 and SC58 be relocated onto the Holland Oil property, to avoid obtaining access agreements from the adjacent landowner, Endo's Auto Service, at 16245 E. 14th Street, San Leandro. Boring SC54 would be moved 40 feet to the east, and boring SC58 would be moved 60 feet to the east. Attached is a modified copy of Figure 2 of the Workplan Addendum showing the original soil boring locations and the proposed relocated soil borings. Also attached is Attachment G/Figure 2 – Satellite Photo with Proposed Boring Locations at Endo's Auto Service.



This photograph shows the parcel boundaries, site features, and the original proposed boring locations at Endo's Auto Service.

The other offsite soil borings (SC48, SC55, SC59, and SC60) are located on the grounds of Edendale Middle School and would be drilled at the locations proposed in the Work Plan Addendum. Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
