Hi again, Jerry,

As I was updating the Geotracker site and including the UST case information, I noticed that the closure of the UST case may mean the closure of well MW-1. In the closure report you sent, it notes that PCE was found in this well at 400 ug/L. Irrespective of its source, this may play a role in the Groth Brothers investigation/cleanup, since PCE exceeds the Water Board environmental screening level in groundwater for the vapor intrusion to indoor air concern.

How this might affect your UST closure may be limited to assessing whether that well should be destroyed or continued to be monitored with respect to PCE. I am cc'ing Jon Rosso to let him know of this possible concern. Let me know if you have any questions.
