Thank you for the follow up message regarding the project schedule. As we discussed earlier today, the following recently denied GeoTracker submittals have been received: GEO\_RPT, GEO\_MAP and EDF, all for the soil investigation for off-site soil bores SB-11 and SB-12.

The EDF associated with the WC (1, 2, & 3) and SB (16, 17, & 18) soil bores for the on-site investigation will remain denied pending the submittal of the Remedial Action Report. This EDF does not need to be resubmitted. I'll revise the submittal date for the Remedial Action Report pending receipt of the permit moratorium information from Paradiso Mechanical Inc.

Thank you for taking the time to speak with me this morning. As you and I discussed, the excavation at this site has been postponed until April due to a moratorium that the City of Oakland has placed on excavation work. I have contacted the contractor, Paradiso Mechanical, Inc. who is going to be doing this work and pulled the permits, and I have requested that they send to you the information from the City of Oakland indicating the moratorium for this work. If you don't hear from Paul Paradiso in the next few days, let me know, and I will contact him again.

Also as we discussed, the report that includes the data from borings WC-1 through WC-3 and SB-16 through SB-18, which were advanced in preparation for the upcoming excavation work, will be submitted as soon as the excavations have been completed.

Please approve the Site Investigation Report and the Geomap in GeoTracker as we discussed. As I indicated, even though this work (SB-11 and SB-12) was completed at the same time, to save costs, this work is separate from the borings discussed above.
