Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the draft figure showing the repositioned location for boring SB-11 submitted to ACEH by email on February 10, 2014. This location is acceptable by ACEH.

ACEH noted the soil boring at the location of the MW-19, proposed in the work plan dated November 22, 2013, prepared by ANTEA Group for the subject site, has been omitted. As requested in ACEH's Directive dated February 7, 2014, please advance a boring at the MW-19 location for the recovery of a grab-groundwater sample as part of the groundwater investigation.

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Workplan for Monitoring Well Installation* dated November 21, 2013 and the figure showing proposed boring locations submitted to ACEH by email dated January 3, 2014. Both documents were prepared by Antea Group (Antea) for the subject site on your behalf. ACEH is in general agreement with the proposed boring locations, designated as MW-18, MW-19, SB-11 and SB-12, for the collection of grab groundwater samples for plume delineation. ACEH requests that you address the following technical comment, submit the requested document, and upon ACEH approval, perform the proposed work, and send us the technical reports requested below.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS

ACEH requests the location for SB-11 be relocated to a position farther down gradient to the southwest along a line determined by the existing MW-14 and the proposed SB-11 location depicted on the January 3, 2014 figure in order to delineate the leading edge of the contaminant plume in this area. Please submit a revised figure for ACEH review.

TECHNICAL REPORT REQUEST

Please upload technical reports to the ACEH ftp site (Attention: Keith Nowell), and to the State Water Resources Control Board's Geotracker website, in accordance with the following specified file naming convention and schedule:

- **February 21, 2014**– Draft figure depicting proposed boring locations;
- **May 9, 2014**– **Groundwater Investigation Report** (file name: RO0000219_SWI_R_yyyy-mm-dd)
