Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Responsible Party Identification

Sylvester Brooks operated and owned the underground storage tanks in 1996 when the USTs were removed. Sylvester Brooks meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because he owned and operated the underground storage tanks (Definition 1) and had control over an underground storage tank at the time or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

W.L. Race Trust owned the property from 1988 to 2008. W.L. Race Trust meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred, (Definition 3).

The Arthur Creggett Trust purchased the property in October 24, 2008. The Arthur Creggett Trust meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred, (Definition 3).

Paul Carpenter purchased the property in August 2009. Paul Carpenter meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because he owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred, (Definition 3).

JB Enterprises, Inc. purchased the property in April 2010. J.B. Enterprises, Inc. meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred, (Definition 3).
