Dear Ms. Jakub:

On behalf of ConocoPhillips (COP) Delta Consultants (Delta) is submitting this Request to Suspend Monitoring and Sampling Events and Status Reports Letter.

This site is currently proposed for closure once the underground storage tanks, waste oil tank, and associated piping is removed.

This site is currently on a semi-annual monitoring and sampling schedule for three onsite monitoring wells.

As stated in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2010 Summary Report, low concentrations of TPHg (320 µg/L) and MTBE (11 µg/L) remain on the site in monitoring well MW-1. Monitoring wells MW-2 and MW-3 have non-detect for these constituents. MW-2 has been non-detect since 2005. MW-6 has been non-detect since 2006. Benzene is non-detect for all three monitoring wells.

On this basis, COP and Delta respectfully request that monitoring and sampling events be suspended as well as suspending status reports for this site.
