This is to respectfully request an extension to February 18, 2011 for the submission of a Soil and Water Investigation (SWI) Report for ConocoPhillips service station 3538 located at 411 West MacArthur in Oakland (Case No. RO0000251).

This is an extension to the January 5th due date established in Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA) letter to ConocoPhillips dated October 5, 2010. This extension is due to a change in the original 2009 scope of work as presented in a November 5, 2010 work plan addendum, as well as the limited availability and schedules of drilling equipment and crews during November & December to perform this assessment.

Delta advanced the three on-site soil and groundwater borings (SB-8 through SB-10) on December 20th & 21st, 2010. Soil and groundwater analytical results from these borings should be available in mid-January. Delta requests approximately 30 days after receipt of laboratory analytical data to review this data and prepare the SWI report. This report will include an evaluation of soil analytical data from borings SB-8 and SB-9 and deeper groundwater analytical results from borings SB-8 and SB-10 as noted in the November 5, 2010 work plan addendum as well as recommendations for future work. Also, these results will be used to evaluate if changes are appropriate for the advancement of off-site borings SB-6 and SB-7.

Off-site access for proposed boring SB-6 and encroachment permits for proposed off-site boring SB-7 are still pending and schedules for advancement of these 2 borings is still undetermined. To maximize drilling efficiency, the advancement of boring SB-7 is proposed at the same time as SB-6 once private property access is obtained. ConocoPhillips has been requesting this access for at least a year.
