On behalf of ARCO Products Company (ARCO), Pacific Environmental Group, Inc. (PACIFIC) thanks you for your cooperation associated with our ongoing groundwater investigation in your area. As you are aware from previous correspondence, we are continuing to investigate the origin of impacted groundwater in the general area under the direction of the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA) and the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB). We expect our investigation to be completed this year. Therefore, we are requesting your continued cooperation in the following areas.

First, PACIFIC requests your authorization to sample the water from your domestic irrigation well on a quarterly basis through 1995. Second, PACIFIC also requests that if **your well is operational** you do not operate your well until the investigation is complete.

QUARTERLY GROUNDWATER SAMPLING

PACIFIC requests authorization to allow us, on behalf of ARCO, to collect samples from your well on a quarterly basis. Groundwater samples collected from your well would more clearly define the groundwater conditions in the area, and that information could expedite our assessment efforts. Each sampling event is performed by one sampling technician, and the process generally requires less than 1 hour at the well. Every effort would be taken to schedule the sampling in advance to minimize any possible disruption to you. A copy of the sampling results would be submitted to you after each quarterly sampling event.

AGREEMENT NOT TO PUMP WELL

PACIFIC, on behalf of ARCO, requests your agreement not to pump the well until ARCO's groundwater investigation is complete, as determined by ACHCSA and the RWQCB. This is requested for the following reasons.

- Petroleum hydrocarbons have been noted in groundwater in wells in your vicinity, and the pumping of your well may complicate this issue for other homeowners in your neighborhood. ACHCSA has requested your cooperation to assure that groundwater is useable to everyone. ACHCSA also encourages everyone to discontinue well use until the investigation is complete.

- PACIFIC has completed a health risk assessment for the study area, which ACHCSA has approved. Even though the results of that assessment indicated that there is no health risk associated with exposure to groundwater, as defined in the assessment, ACHCSA and ARCO believe it is prudent to minimize exposure to the groundwater until the investigation is complete.

In exchange for not using your irrigation well, ARCO is prepared to reimburse you \$30 per month for the expense of using municipally-supplied water for irrigation purposes. This reimbursement rate is greater than the estimated cost of using municipally-supplied water for irrigation purposes based on high-usage assumptions for your neighborhood.

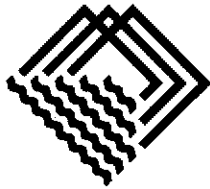

Every effort would be taken to schedule the inspection or sampling in advance to minimize any possible disruption to you. A copy of the sampling results, if applicable would be submitted to you after each quarterly sampling event.
