Analytical data was not collected for naphthalene between 0 to 5 and 5 to 10 feet below grade surface (bgs), and for benzene and ethylbenzene from 5 to 10 feet bgs. The maximum concentration of gasoline that has been reported at the site was 172 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) at a depth of 5 feet below grade surface (bgs). 


