As you are aware, the public comment period for the subject site ended on May 31, 2015. No comments were received by Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH). Provided a completed copy of the List of Landowners Form is returned to ACEH, you are free to proceed with the destruction of groundwater monitoring wells associated with the site, as discussed in the attached March 26, 2015 letter from ACEH. Please be aware that the disposal of all potentially contaminated media generated during the well destruction process requires documentation of final acceptance at the disposal facility prior to closure. Construction debris does not require disposal documentation, only a statement that it has been properly disposed of.

Please provide 72-hour advance written notification to this office (e-mail preferred to mark.detterman@acgov.org) prior to the start of field activities.

- 4 Weeks After Completion of All Required Submittal Tasks Uniform Closure Letter Issued (Provided the List of Landowners Form has been submitted)

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.
