On behalf of Golden Empire Properties and in response to the Alameda County Health Care Services (ACHCS) letter dated May 21, 1998, Cambria Environmental Technology (Cambria) is submitting this addendum to the corrective action plan (CAP) dated April 8, 1998, for the former Exxon Service Station located at 3055 35th Avenue in Oakland, California.

As requested by Mr. Barney Chan of the ACHCS, Cambria will drill one additional boring along 35th Avenue, near the intersection with School street. A grab groundwater sample will be collected from the boring and analyzed for TPHg, BTEX, and MTBE for upgradient delineation of the dissolved-phase gasoline plume. Sampling procedures are described in our corrective action plan. A site plan with the proposed drilling locations is attached.
