Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has been made aware the subject case has been placed in the Expedited Claim Account Program (ECAP). I, the ACEH caseworker, am unaware if ACEH has received official notification from the ECAP that the site has been accepted and am unaware if anyone at the State Clean Up Fund (CUF) has been assigned to the case.

ACEH has had a meeting scheduled for Thursday, March 10, 2016, for the subject case with the Responsible Party (RP) prior to being made aware of the acceptance of the case to the ECAP. ACEH believes it is premature to hold a meeting with only the RP and ACEH staff in light of the case acceptance into the ECAP. Hence, ACEH will postpone the meeting until such time that the entire ECAP team can be present.

Please have the ECAP staff inform ACEH of the case and ECAP team status as the program takes flight.
