3/14/97 Reviewed over the analytical results from the tank removal. Called SEMCO and spoke to Rhonda (415) 572-8033. Since ~~no~~ benzene was ^{not} identified in samples & concentrations of other contaminants were very low and below the EPA's PRG levels for a residential site, no additional investigations will be required. However, since the chromium conc. equaled four times the STC, an STC analysis should be done ^{for Cr}. And ultimately a tank removal report should be submitted.
