Reviewed over the analytical results from the tank removal. Called SEMCO and spoke to Rhonda (415)572-8033. Since ~~the~~ benzene was <sup>not</sup> identified in samples & concentrations of other contaminants were very low and below the EPA's PR6 levels for a residential site, no additional investigations will be required. However, since the chromium conc. equalled ten times the SLC, an SLC<sup>for Cr</sup> analysis should be done. And ultimately a tank removal report should be submitted.
