Dear Mr. Smith:

Groundwater Technology, Inc. has been retained by Chevron U.S.A. Inc to provided environmental consulting services at the subject site. With the completion of the well abandonment, Groundwater Technology is now ready to proceed with the next phase of work, the installation of four, on-site groundwater monitoring wells. The proposed wells will be constructed of 3/4-inch polyvinyl chloride and conform to the specifications presented in the letter submitted to you dated March 8, 1991. The attached figure shows the proposed monitoring well locations.

During soil coring, soil samples will be retained from each hole for laboratory analysis. These samples will be collected using standard Groundwater Technology procedures for environmental sampling and transported to a California State-certified laboratory for analysis. The samples will be analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH)-as-gasoline and benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX). Water samples extracted from the wells will be analyzed for the same compounds.

After completion of all phases of field work, Groundwater Technology will prepare a technical report detailing the results and findings of this investigation.
