I spoke with Paul King today. He's been retained by Xtra Oil to handle the generation of a final UST closure report. I believe he's also going to be handling the future Env investigation and remediation tasks as well. We spoke at some length regarding all these topics. Because of some complications, the closure report will not be ready until late January at the earliest. One of the complicating factors is that Kip Porter of K+B Environmental cannot at this time be found. He may be in Colorado at this time. Mr. Porter has all the information surrounding the UST replacement that is needed for the final closure report. Further, K+B Env. is no longer Xtra Oil consultancy, for whatever reason.

These facts may, perhaps temporarily, slow down the final design, construction, and implementation of the remediation system. Both VE and GWE plumbing was installed in the site during UST replacement. Elyse Heilshorn of Heilshorn Env. Engineering (HE²) assisted K+B Env. during the conceptual stage of the remediation system design. It was with she and Kip Porter that I met ~10 months ago to discuss the logistics and scheduling for the UST replacement and remediation system ~~and~~ construction at the site. Paul King is well acquainted with Ms. Heilshorn and will be in contact with her in regards to the remediation system.

Memo to file:

I spoke with both Kip Porter (K+B Env.) and Mike Collier (Walton Eng.) re: this site yesterday. They indicated that on one portion of the site (north/south?) the pump island was completely removed, as was the piping, and the soil completely removed to the top of a dark "clay" layer. No samples were collected initially in the piping trenches as required.

I told Mr. Porter and Mr. Collier both that I needed to be on-site to observe the [redacted] in-situ, note their condition, and witness sampling of the trenches per the 20 linear foot criteria. I asked that continued "over excavation" of the fueling pads/piping runs should stop. I said it was alright to uncover the area as long as I can be sure to see the pipes as they lay.

I reiterated to Mr. Porter that initial samples are still required before overexcavation. He agreed that I was correct but indicated that he was not on-site when the previous work was done. I told him that he really ought to be to help guide the contractor and client in the way work progresses here.

I will be on-site today (7/29/92) to witness sampling of the (remaining) pipe trenches.

This memo documents a phone conversation this date with John Cousins of Calif. Geophysical Group, the consultant engaged currently to perform the groundwater / soil investigation.

We agreed to continue monthly H₂O level monitoring and sampling through the end of this quarter. A report documenting the July, August & September sampling will be written. We further agreed to hold off the need to install additional up-/down-gradient wells until this info is available; this will help to better site additional wells.

I informed Mr. Cousins that the RWQCB has provisions to require "affected property" owners to allow wells to be installed on their properties.

I also agreed that the over excavation of the waste oil pit may proceed.

John Cussen (CA Geophysical Engr) and I spoke today regarding the recent submittal of the May 10, 1991 quarterly report, and his June 7, 1991 letter which responded to my 19 Apr 91 correspondence.

I asked him to include the signature of his firm's CEO, Richard Merriam, on all future reports and proposals which involve environmental work or recommendations.

I approved his plans for the geophysical survey, although he was not sure whether Ted Simas was still desiring this approach. He would get back with me later.

I told him that Ted (Simas) had requested a reduction in sampling frequency (June 4 letter). I told him that I was not comfortable reducing frequencies yet because the data has yet to stabilize longer than a couple of mes. in a row; I want to see the next data set before committing to a reduction in sampling.

A copy of the RWQCB workplan guidelines were attached to Mr. Cussen.

Terry Carter of Aqua Science called regarding soil investigation at the Xtra Oil site noted above. ~~Mr. Carter indicated that samples were collected approx. 8 months ago even though no work plan had been submitted for our review.~~ The fact that no plan was submitted prompted the issuance of a Second Notice of Violation from this office dated May 25, 1989. Mr. Carter indicated that he has received a verbal laboratory analyses report, as follows:

T.O.G. - 440 ppm
TPH-D - ~ 940 ppm
BTXE/Cl.HC - near detection limits

He will be submitting a discussion of what has taken place regarding this sampling episode in letter to be received by next week. Further, Aqua Terra has been retained to conduct an investigation at the site. A proposal for this work will be submitted within 30 days.
