Steven and Paresh:

1. The contractor has started excavating for bulk removal.

- 2. The first phase will be to 3 feet depth. He will then install shoring to border the excavation on the two sides with buildings. The shoring will be driven to 20 feet depth, while soil removal will be only to 8 feet depth below current parking lot elevation, per the plan.
- 3. The three feet depth is so that lateral bracing can be installed for the shoring at that depth, per his site-specific engineered shoring plan.
- 4. The shoring will be installed beginning Monday May 5.
- 5. On Saturday May 10, the contractor will begin bulk excavation at 4am. He plans excavate the entire pit that day, loading the contaminated soil into trucks for delivery to the landfill that day. Excavation will only be to the 45' x 40' area and to 8' depth per the approved ICAP work plan.
- 6. We will have a DHS-certified mobile lab on site for closure sample analysis for the chemicals in County's plan approval letter.
- 7. After closure samples are collected, he will, depending on the time, begin backfill with crushed rock, per the plans.

If the schedule changes, we will advise you.
