Fund technical staff have reviewed your request, received on April 7, 2008, for preapproval of corrective action costs.

With the following provisions, the total cost pre-approved as eligible for reimbursement for completing the February 29, 2008, Oro Loma Sanitary District workplan approved by the RWQCB, Region 2 (Regional Board) in their June 30, 2008 letter, is \$240,700; see the table below for a breakdown of costs.

Be aware that this pre-approval does not constitute a decision on reimbursement: necessary (as determined by the Fund) corrective action costs for action work directed and approved by the Regional Board will be eligible for reimbursement at costs consistent with those pre-approved in this letter. However, depending on what happens in the field, some costs may not actually be necessary.

All costs for corrective action must meet the requirements of Article 11, Chapter 16. Underground Storage Tank Regulations in order to be eligible for reimbursement.

- Only the tasks/costs reflected on the above table are pre-approved at this time. The
 Fund will review any tasks/costs that go beyond the pre-approved amount to be
 determined if the additional tasks and costs are necessary and reasonable.
- Mobilization/demobilization costs will be paid after review of invoices for actual costs incurred. Lump sum invoices for mob/demob will be rejected.
- The work products must be acceptable to the Regional Board.
- If a different scope of work becomes necessary, then you must request pre-approval
 of costs on the new scope of work.
- Although I have referred to the Oro Loma Sanitary District proposal in my preapproval above, please be aware that you will be entering into a private contract: the
 State of California cannot compel you to sign any specific contract. This letter preapproves the costs as presented in the proposal dated February 29, 2008 by Oro
 Loma Sanitary District for conducting the work approved by the County

I also want to remind you that the Fund's regulations require that you obtain at least three bids, or a bid waiver from Fund staff, from qualified firms for all necessary future corrective action work. If you need assistance in procuring contractor and consultant services, don't hesitate to call me.

Please remember that it is still necessary to submit the actual costs of the work as explained in the Reimbursement Request Instructions to confirm that the costs are

consistent with this pre-approval before you will be reimbursed. Please insure that your consultant prepares their invoices to include the required breakdown of costs on a time and materials basis, that invoiced tasks are consistent with the original proposal, and that reasonable explanations are provided for any changes made in the scope of work or increases in the costs. When the invoices are submitted you must include copies of all:

- subcontractor invoices,
- technical reports, when available, and
- applicable correspondence from the Regional Board.
