I want to informed you that Mr. James Hanlon with Accutite has retired and they (Accutite) cannot move forward with assisting the District with this case due to the loss of their Geologist. I'm in the process of obtaining advised and consultation with a company call Fugro USA Land, Inc.. Mr. Dave Sadoff a Geologist with Fugro has been working closely with me and has provided some useful advise on how the District can close this case with the use of soil boring. I appreciate your willingness to explore this option which will be the least expensive way to go for the District.

I have requested that Mr. Sadoff send me a proposal for his services and to write a new work plan for the soil boring. During this process to get Fugro on board I am seeking an extension on behalf of the Oakland Unified School District in order to complete the task necessary to close out the fuel leak case associated with 2607 Myrtle Street which in my opinion is long over due.
