A groundwater extraction and treatment system was operated from May 22, 2006 through December 23, 2009, at the City of Oakland Municipal Services Center located at 7101 Edgewater Drive, Oakland, California. The treated groundwater was discharged into local storm drain under the above referenced Regional Water Quality Control Board Order and the NPDES Permit. Quarterly and annual self-monitoring reports have been uploaded to the State GeoTracker System.

The remediation system has successfully achieved its design goal – complete removal of separate phase hydrocarbons from the site. With the concurrence of the Local Oversight Agency – Alameda County Environmental Health, the City will remove the remediation system from the site. Therefore, the City requests the termination of the NPDES discharge authorization for the site, effective on November 10, 2010.
