**Comments:**

Here are some preliminary results for the samples collected last week from the Nahas site. It looks to me like we don't have a major contamination problem at the bottom of the UST excavation.

[REDACTED] (< 1mg/Kg) for several of the 8270 analytes (see copy of Analysis - Page 2 attached).

The composited stockpile samples collected 11/17/98 indicate that this excavated material should be the primary concern for this project. I've checked with Ted DeWilde of Vasco Road landfill, and this material appears to be acceptable for disposal at their facility. I do plan to collect three more sets of samples from the stockpile today, and should be able to profile this material after the new results have been received.
