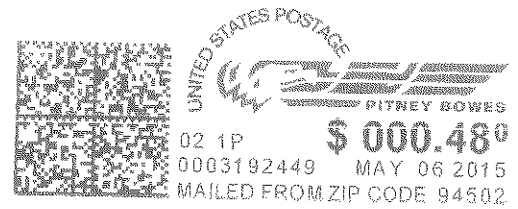

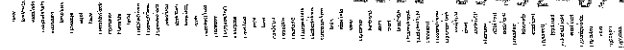

Dear Responsible Parties:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) is considering the above referenced site for potential case closure. As you are aware a site investigation and groundwater monitoring for underground storage tank releases has been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible parties.

Public participation, a requirement for the case closure process, has been initiated and will end on June 3, 2015.

Monitoring Well Destruction and Waste Removal Activities

ACEH is requesting that you schedule well destruction activities for no earlier than two (2) weeks after the end of the public notification period. Please provide ACEH (Attention: Keith Nowell) confirmation that the permitting for and well destruction has been scheduled. ACEH will request/authorize the well destruction in a separate letter following the conclusion of the public notification period.

Following the well destruction, please provide ACEH a well destruction report according to the schedule outlined below. The well destruction report should document site activities, provide well destruction permit documentation, and documentation indicating that any remaining investigation, remediation, and well destruction derived waste have been removed from the site.
