Dear Mr. Detterman:

We have received your October 27, 2009, letter to Mr. Lee. We propose the following action items to comply with the Technical Comments of that letter:

- 1. We propose to examine, clean and repair as necessary all on-site wells plus MW-8 (off-site) on or about the second week in December, 2009.
- 2. We propose to monitor and sample all on-site wells, plus MW-8 through MW-14 (off-site) for the Fourth Quarter, 2009.
- 3. A Preferential Pathway study was included in the 2007 Corrective Action Plan. Since the principal transmissive formation is found from approximately 25-38 feet below ground surface, no potential conduits were discovered that could be reasonably expected to affect the spread of contaminants.
- 4. We propose to review the available site data and recommend changes to the monitoring well construction and/or monitoring schedule in accord with your requested January 15, 2010 date.
