WORK PERFORMED THIS PERIOD (Fourth Quarter 2011):

- 1. In accordance with ACEHD correspondence dated July 24, 2009 regarding SWRCB's Resolution No. 2009-0042, no groundwater monitoring/sampling activities were conducted during the fourth quarter 2011.
- 2. On December 16, 2011, Stratus prepared a *Well Destruction Report* detailing activities associated with the destruction of monitoring well MW-6.

WORK PROPOSED FOR NEXT PERIOD (First Quarter 2012):

- During first quarter 2012, Stratus will conduct semi-annual groundwater monitoring and sampling activities at the site. During this event, all existing groundwater monitoring wells will be gauged, and wells MW-1A, MW-8, MW-9, MW-10, MW-12, MW-13, and MW-14 will be purged and sampled. The privately-owned irrigation well located at 141 Farrelly Drive will also be sampled (without purging), if access is allowed. All groundwater samples will be forwarded to a state-certified analytical laboratory for analysis.
- 2. Upon receipt of concurrence from ACEHD, Stratus will prepare a corrective action plan (CAP) for the implementation of a dual phase extraction (DPE) system at the site.
