Ensco Environmental Services, Inc. (EES) is submitting this amendment to our plan for additional work at the above referenced site based on our phone conversation. The original work plan proposed drilling two soil borings at the site.

As per your instructions, EES will drill the original two soil borings, B-1 and B-2, and add a third soil boring, B-3, near the northeastern pump island as shown in Figure 2.

Soil samples will be analyzed at a state-certified laboratory for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHG) and benzene, toluene, ethyl benzene and xylenes (BTEX).
