Mark,

I looked at your last report briefly and have just a few things that I would be concerned with so far. I would like to see TBA analysis for the wells after remediation and I do not see EDB or EDC analysis at all. I would also need to review all of the lateral and vertical definition data to see if the site is fully defined. A nice cross section with all of the soil and groundwater data would be helpful, if you can direct me to one that was prepared or have one prepared for submittal in your Corrective Actions Report. Also, was a well survey performed? I'm not really sure how close the Fitchburg well field is to the site or if there are any other wells in use nearby. If a well survey hasn't been performed that would be an additional data gap that would be required before closure.

If you are interested in advancing this case to closure the attached case closure summary can be filled out and sent as a word document to me via e-mail. Do not delete any section. If there is a section that does not apply for some reason, leave it blank or write NA.

Thanks Barbara.

I can answer a few of your questions. You will find limited EDB and EDC data in Table III of the RI/FS report for the site (or any quarterly report - one time at well MW-2 only). We have generally surmised that like MTBE, other fuel oxygenates will have decreased (MTBE to <5 ug/L). You will also find two cross sections in the RI/FS report; Figures 4 and 5 (section lines on Figure 2), but without analytical appended to the sections. A well survey has not been conducted; however, something to be requested.

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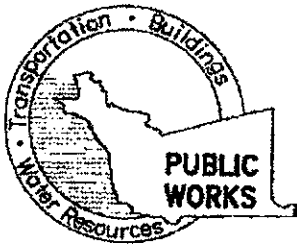
