Thanks for your time last week. Our proposed compliance schedule for tasks associated with 160 Holmes St. is as follows:

- 1. ISCO remedial report Submitted by August 30, 2013
- 2. Confirmatory soil sampling report Submitted by August 30, 2013
- 3. Bio-barrier evaluation/recommendation Submitted by August 30, 2013

As described in our May 8, 2013 work plan, ISCO field activities are just now finishing up and additional time is needed to adequately assess the effectiveness of these remedial activities. The extra time will allow us to include the results of proposed confirmatory soil sampling, as well as the results of 2nd and 3rd quarter 2013 groundwater monitoring events, in the remedial evaluation report. Based on these results, we will also determine if the proposed ORC biodegradation barrier is still needed. The bulleted tasks above will be included in one all-inclusive report submitted to ACEH by August 30, 2013.
