

Alameda County Environmental Health staff has recently reviewed the case file for the subject site including the July 30, 2004 Investigation/Well Destruction Workplan and the August 9, 2004 Addendum to Investigation/Well Destruction Workplan prepared by Cambria, your consultant, The work plans intend to provide additional soil and groundwater investigation and supplement future analytical results from pending underground storage tank and piping removal. The four existing monitoring wells are also proposed for proper destruction to facilitate the planned redevelopment of this property. The status of the site will be based upon the results of the proposed investigation and the results from the tank removal samples, with site closure sought. Therefore, the proposed work should be comprehensive in the event the tank removal results do not warrant additional investigation. We request that you address the following technical comments when performing the proposed work and submit the technical reports requested below.

#### TECHNICAL COMMENTS

- 1. Conduit Study- we request that you perform a conduit study that details the potential migration pathways and conduits (utilities, storm drains, etc) that may be present in the vicinity of the site. Provide a map showing the location and depths of all utilities lines and trenches within and near the plume area.
- 2. Soil Borings- the proposed borings are concentrated in the northern section of the property, however, the petroleum release (MTBE) has been observed over a much larger area of the site. Our office recommends a transect of borings immediately up-gradient of and down-gradient of the sources ie dispenser islands and USTs. This can be done with one additional boring and moving the locations of the two northernmost samples to the east. A modified Figure 2 is attached indicating these locations. We concur with the proposal to collect depth discrete soil and groundwater samples at 5 and 11' bgs, however, sampling should be sufficient to determine the vertical extent of contamination. A soil sample should be collected and analyzed at changes in lithology and in areas of obvious contamination. At least one boring from each transect should be advanced to 25'bgs to confirm the geology noted during the initial MW installations. Please prepare cross-section diagrams with the data generated. We concur with the proposed analytes.
- 3. Waste Oil Tank- elevated TOG was left in place within the former waste oil tank pit. Please consider excavation of this area once the station building is demolished. MW-4 is located adjacent and up-gradient of the waste oil tank. A groundwater sample within or immediately down-gradient of this tank should be analyzed for the TPHmo, TPHd, TPHg, BTEX, MTBE and ether oxygenates and lead scavengers.

- 4. UST System Removal- we concur with the proposal to over-excavate obvious contamination observed at the time of the tank removals. Please take the required regulatory samples prior to performing any over-excavation.
- 5. MW Destruction- please refer to Alameda County Public Works Agency, Mr. James Yoo (670-6633) for permitting and well destruction requirements and methodology.



This office has reviewed the 1st Quarter 1997 Monitoring Report and your attached cover letter, dated February 25, 1997, for the above site. Per your letter you requested the following:

- "1. Monitor and sample MW-1 and MW-2 for 2 additional quarters for TPH-G, BTEX, and MTBE.
  - o If MTBE is detected in MW-1 and MW-2 by EPA Method 8020, then confirm the detection using EPA Method 8260.
  - o If a relatively stable or decreasing trend is established for MTBE after two additional quarters, then reduce the monitoring and sampling frequency to annual because TPH-G and BTEX have been essentially non-detect or relatively low in concentration.
- 2. Eliminate the monitoring and sampling of MW-3 and MW-4 because the results over the last several years have consistently shown non-detectable levels of TPH-G, BTEX, and MTBE."

In reference to proposal #1, this office agrees that the monitoring frequency of Wells MW-1 and MW-2 should be reevaluated after two additional quarters. However, if MTBE concentrations remain relatively the same for the two quarters, then semi-annual sampling should be conducted for Wells MW-1 and MW-2 to assure that concentrations are not sporadic and will not continue to increase in the future. If MTBE concentrations definitely appear to be attenuating within the two quarters, then Wells MW-1 and MW-2 may be switched to annual monitoring. If future sampling events (quarterly, semi-annual, or annual) indicate that MTBE concentrations are increasing and there is an on-going source of this contamination, then continued quarterly groundwater monitoring, as well as some additional plume characterization, may be required.

In reference to proposal #2, this office does not agree that Wells MW-3 and MW-4 should be eliminated from the monitoring program. Both of these wells have intermittently detected levels of TPHg and BTEX at least several times since sampling of these wells began in 1991. The highest contaminant concentrations historically identified in Well MW-4, which was appreciably higher than previous quarters, were noted in a very recent sampling event conducted in October 1996, indicating a possible on-going source. The detection of contaminants in these wells have regularly occurred in the latter part of each year, which seems to correlate with deeper water tables. Due to the higher contaminant concentrations recently identified in Well MW-4 in

October 1996, and the fact that sampling of these wells may help to explain the increasing MTBE concentrations, this office is requesting that you continue to sample Wells MW-3 and MW-4 on an annual basis. These annual sampling events should take place in the latter part of the year, some time between July and October, due to historical contaminant concentration patterns.

As addressed in your letter, the Regional Water Quality Control Board is currently working to develop some guidelines for MTBE, and changes to the above requirements may be warranted when these MTBE guidelines have been completed.





Dear Mr. Kan,

This office has reviewed Chevron's request for site closure. Based on the fact that low levels of BTEX are still being identified intermittently in three of the four on-site wells, this office is requiring that Chevron conduct quarterly ground water monitoring at the site for at least another year to confirm that contaminant concentrations in the ground water have stabilized or will attenuate through time.

Additionally, elevated levels of Oil & Grease were identified during excavation and sampling of the former waste oil tank pit (up to 16,000 parts per million on the southern end and 3,200 parts per million on the northern end of the tank pit). The extent of Oil & Grease contamination in the soil was never delineated and ground water samples were never collected from downgradient of the former waste oil tank area. This office is requesting that Chevron take measures to confirm that the ground water has not been impacted downgradient of the former waste oil tank, and that efforts be made to delineate the extent of Oil & Grease contaminated soil. Although you stated, in your June 15, 1994 letter to this office, that drilling additional borings in the service bay will be difficult, other options may be available for delineating the soil contamination, such as slant borings.



According to our phone conversation on June 1, 1994, you requested additional samples near the used oil tank. Based on field observations, it maybe impossible to take additional samples near the used oil tank because of a two post hoist and underground utility lines in the vicinity of the used oil tank. Both the alignment rack and underground utility lines will make it difficult to drill for additional soil samples. It is possible to locate a boring in the front parking lot of the restaurant. However, this boring may not yield any beneficial information. It is unlikely that oil and grease impacted soil would extend to the other side of the service bay. Copies of photographs showing the service bay and used oil tank are enclosed.

In our phone conversation, you also requested additional information on the disposition of the soil that was generated from our excavation. Based on our records, it appears the soil was disposed at Redwood Landfill in Novato and Forward Landfill in Stockton. A listing of 1991 invoices from Redwood and Forward is enclosed.







Based on the latest sampling results, Chevron is requesting case closure of the above referenced site. All of the required information in the Tri-Regional Board Staff Recommendations for Preliminary Evaluation and Investigation of Underground Storage Tank Sites Table 3, Section II Closure is written below.

#### Site History

On April 11, 1991, four single-walled fiberglass underground storage tanks along with the piping were removed as part of a reconstruction project. All four tanks were visually inspected by a representative from Alameda Co. Environmental Health, and no holes were found in any of the four tanks. The single-walled tanks and lines were later replaced with double-walled fiberglass tanks and lines.

Based on the enclosed documents titled "Quarterly Review of Dealer Inventory Records", there appears to be no discrepancies in the dealer's inventory records.

The tanks were installed in 1972 and were last tested on July 9, 1990. There are no documents regarding any repairs to the tanks and all four tanks passed the tank test on July 9, 1990.

The average amount of product pumped from each tank could not be found. However, the station's average for all types of fuel over a twelve month period was 179808 gals. in 1985, 180748 gals. in 1986, and 192878 gals. in 1987.

At the request of Chevron, RESNA conducted a 1/2 mile survey of all nearby wells and potential off-site sources. (Refer to the enclosed 1/2 mile survey)

Again at the request of Chevron, RESNA researched other sources for site specific information. RESNA contracted with BBL of Solana Beach, California which checks the following government databases: National Priority List (NPL), Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability System (CERCLIS), Federal Facilities, RCRA Violators List, Superfund Liens, Federal Dockets, Annual Work Plan, CALSITES, CORTESE, Solid Waste

Assessment Test [SWAT (S)], Solid Waste Information System (SWIS), California State - Leaking Underground Storage Tanks [LUST (S)], Regional - Leaking Underground Storage Tanks [LUST (R)], Unauthorized Releases, Toxic Pits (Regional), Solid Waste Assessment Test [SWAT (R)], and Well Investigative Program. (Refer to the enclosed report from BBL)

#### Site Characteristics

In the tank removal report, there was no reference of any staining or odors. A sheen was observed during the removal of the tanks.

Based on the boring logs of four wells, it appears the entire site consist of sand.

A map showing showing nearby waterbodies (ie. ponds, lakes, river, etc.) is enclosed.

#### Sampling And Analysis

Additional samples beyond the required samples were taken. Additional samples were taken when the product lines were removed and when over-excavation occurred. All sampling and analytical procedures followed the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) - San Francisco Bay Region guidelines. In all cases, the appropriate analysis at the time was used in analyzing the samples. The laboratory QA/QCs were included in the reports that were submitted to the agencies.

Since water was present in both tank locations at approximately 6 - 6.5 feet below grade, sidewall samples as well as groundwater samples were collected.

Soil samples were collected every 20 lineal feet of product piping. In addition, samples were obtained underneath every ninety degree elbow and along side each dispenser.

The depth and location of each sample along with the analytical results were submitted to Alameda Co. Dept. of Environmental Health and the RWQCB-San Francisco Bay Region and were recorded in Blaine Tech's report dated April 11, 1991 and Geraghty & Miller's report dated October 1991.

#### Remediation

Approximately 400 cu. yds. of soil was generated from removing the product tanks and approximately 50 cu. yds. was generated from removing the used oil tank. Another 42 cubic of soil was removed from the over-excavation of the used oil tank. Another 300 cu. yds. of soil was removed from the over-excavation of the product tank area. Approximately 210 cu. yds. of soil was generated from the over-excavation of the product lines. Overall, approximately 1002 cu. yds. of soil was removed from the site. Throughout the excavation, a representative from Alameda Co. Department of Environmental periodically visited the site. Water was removed from the excavated area.

Based on the latest quarterly monitoring and sampling report, levels have been below or close to

the detection limit. Groundwater conditions with the exception of one anomalous reading in MW-4 and two readings of 72 and 78 ppb TPH-G in well MW-2 have been below the Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs) and Taste and Odor Thresholds cited by U.S. EPA in the Federal Register of 1989 since January 1993. Two wells MW-1 and MW-3 have been below the MCLs and Taste and Odor Threshold longer.

Based on the above written information, Chevron request case closure of the above referenced site.

For additional information, refer to the enclosed reports including Sierra Environmental Services quarterly monitoring and sampling report dated May 9, 1994. This office has reviewed Sierra Environmental's Quarterly Ground Water Monitoring Report, dated July 26, 1994, for the above site. According to GTEL Environmental Laboratories (GTEL), who conducted the analysis on the recently collected ground water samples, an "uncategorized compound [observed in two of the ground water samples] was not included in the [reported] gasoline concentrations." Per my conversation with Brian Wagner, GTEL, on September 7, 1994, GTEL has deduced from the generated chromatogram, that the "uncategorized compound" is methyl tertbutyl ether (MTBE). GTEL roughly estimates that the identified concentrations of MTBE range anywhere from 100 to 1,000 ppb. Based on the information available to me, the petroleum industry began using MTBE as a gasoline additive in about 1986 or 1987. According to our records, the gas tanks were removed from the above site in 1991. Therefore, the observed MTBE concentrations could be attributable to the site's former tanks.

You are required to analyze for MTBE, using Method 8240, in the next sampling event to confirm GTEL's theory regarding the "uncategorized compound". If the unknown compound is identified, and is not attributable to an off-site source, analysis for this constituent shall be included in future monitoring events.



This office has received and reviewed Geraghty and Miller's Quarterly Ground water Monitoring Report, dated December 29, 1992. In the past several quarterly monitoring reports submitted for the above site, the ground water surface elevations were not contoured with the argument that the ground water surface is relatively flat at the site. However, in looking at the history of water elevation determinations for the site, there appears to be some substantial fluctuations in the pattern of varying water levels for the on-site wells. Additionally, the ground water surface was shown to have a considerable slope of approximately 0.025 for this last quarter (This is with the assumption that the elevation for MW-2 on Table 1, 1.61, was correct and not the one given in Figure 1).

You will be required to begin submitting elevation contours on the site maps with each of the quarterly monitoring reports. This will enable this office to more efficiently review the behavior of the varying ground water gradient and to assure that all the potential migration pathways of the ground water contaminant plume have been addressed.

However, it does appear that all three of the other wells in addition to your new tanks are down gradient from MW-2. Your second quarter of monitoring should be done in January 1992.

Samples were collected from the former product trenches. was detected at concentrations ranging from ND to 5700 ppm. Overexcavation was performed to remove the elevated levels of contamination. Final excavation samples collected contained TPH-G at concentrations ranging from ND to 150 ppm.

Based on these findings, it appears that no further soils remediation work is warranted in the areas of the newly installed tanks and piping. Chevron has contracted with Geraghty & Miller to prepare a work plan for Phase I Site Assessment and to evaluate the oil & grease soils that remain in the area of the waste oil tank that were unable to be excavated for the appropriate remedial approach. A work plan will be prepared and forwarded to you for your review no later than July 5, 1991.

TO: THE OPERATORS AND OWNERS OF UNDERGROUND STORAGE FACILITIES OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES

#### Gentlemen:

During the 1984 State legislative session, Assemblyman Sher from San Mateo County introduced Assembly Bill 1362 for purposes of protecting underground water supplies from being contaminated by unauthorized releases of hazardous substances from underground storage tanks. This Assembly Bill was passed by the Legislature and signed by the Governor. This became the State of California statute regulating the "Underground Storage of Hazardous Substances." (Division 20, Chapter 6.7, Section 25280-25299.6 of the Health and Safety Code).

On January 31, 1985, the Alameda County Board of Supervisors assumed responsibility for the enforcement of this law and assigned the task of implementation to the Department of Environmental Health.

The cities of Fremont, Hayward, Pleasanton, San Leandro, Union City, Berkeley and Newark adopted separate city ordinances regarding this subject and, are excluded from enforcement by the County. All of the unincorporated area of the County and the balance of the cities remain the responsibility of the County for enforcement.

You or your company were required by the statute to register your underground storage tanks with the State Water Resources Control Board prior to January 1, 1986 or face a penalty. We have been provided with an inventory of those registrations. If you or your company did not register your tank or you have subsequently discovered a tank that has not been registered, please complete an application for a permit to operate. We do not anticipate any penalties or prosecution for late registration. You will find enclosed a computer generated application made from your previous registration. Blank application forms are enclosed for your use, if needed.

Enclosed we are forwarding informal sampling results for the underground storage tank and associated product piping removal. This work was being performed to allow for the installation of new doublewall fiberglass tanks and associated piping. These results also incorporate the final samples collected during the overexcavation activities undertaken beneath the areas of the former product piping trenches. A formal report will be generated and forwarded to you at a later date.

As indicated in the sampling results, elevated levels of petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soils were encountered beneath the former product piping trenches. As agreed to in the telephone conversation March 6, 1991, between yourself and Ms. Cynthia Wong, the piping trenches were over excavated in an attempt to remove identified "hot" spots. Contingent upon completing this agreed to over excavation, you would approve backfilling of the excavation.

On March 7, 1991, the over excavation of the elevated areas commenced beneath the former product trenches. The excavation was limited vertically to the depth of groundwater and laterally to a point where the existing canopy foundations and support columns would not be compromised. Final excavation samples collected detected TPH-gasoline concentrations ranging from ND to 150 ppm.

Based on the final sampling results, it is apparent that a preliminary site assessment is required. Allowing sufficient time to review the sampling results and site background data, prepare and submit a workplan for your approval, obtain all necessary permits, and perform work, we have placed a July 1, 1991, due date for completion of this work and submittal of a report of findings.

Upon completing full definition of the extent of the petroleum hydrocarbon contamination, we will provide recommendations for appropriate remedial actions.

One final comment, we strongly urge you to reconsider the requirement of over excavating soils containing elevated levels of contamination. Sometimes, insitu treatment is more appropriate. We are not arguing against the need to take remedial actions at gasoline contaminated sites. We are only requesting that you remark allow responsible parties to annual the remark allow responsible parties to annual the remark allows. allow responsible parties to apply the best technical approach from an overall environmental protection, safety, and cost efficient standpoint. Both responsible parties and regulators should take into consideration factors such as public exposure, safety, and whether treatment instead of disposal is in the publics as well as the environments best interest.

Prior to our next planned tank removal we would like to present a decision criteria plan which will lay out specific actions that will be taken for various conditions encountered during the excavation process. We would greatly appreciate your consideration of this approach.



NO SMOKING, EATING, DRINKING, OR APPLICATION OF COSMETICS IN THE ZONE.

NO MATCHES OR LIGHTERS IN THIS ZONE.

HAVE SOBA AVAILABLE IN THIS ZONE.

IF YOU DISCOVER ANY SIGNS OF EXPLOSIVITY, OR UNUSUAL CONDITIONS, EXIT IMMEDIATELY AND REPORT THIS FINDING TO YOUR SUPERVISOR.

LIST TO BE POSTED COMSPICUOUSLY AT LOCATION.

REVIEWED BY FIELD TEAM LEADER OR PROJECT TEAM LEADER WITH THE FIELD CREW AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH WORK DAY.

IN ADDITION TO THE STANDING ORDERS, A HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE INFORMATION FORM THAT LISTS THE NAMES AND PROPERTIES OF CHEMICALS PRESENT ON SITE SHOULD BE PREPARED AND POSTED CONSPICUOUSLY. EMPLOYEES SHOULD BE BRISFED ON THE CHEMICAL INFORMATION AT THE BEGINNING OF THE PROJECT OR WHENEVER THEY FIRST JOIN THE WORK TEAM. DAILY SAFETY MESTINGS SHOULD BE HELD FOR ALL EMPLOYEES.

WORKING WITH TOOLS AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT IS A MAJOR HAZARD AT SITES. THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONS WILL HELP PRECLUDE INJURIES DUE TO SUCH HAZARDS:


