Hi Paul,

Well they were proposed as temporary; however, permanent would definitely also be appropriate, would be protective (DTSC guidelines indicate multiple sampling events are strongly preferred), and would be minimal additional cost (to install at least). This may also be dependent on the results of more recent vapor sampling. Still, permanent would be preferred for the residential situation.
