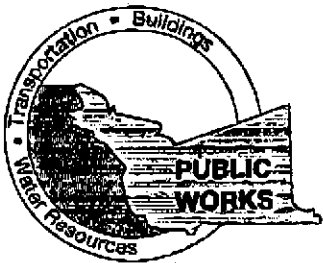

This is a follow-up to our telephone discussion on January 30, 1996, regarding the removal of a groundwater monitoring well at the subject service station. This monitoring well is located on the westerly side of the property, within the planter area fronting Redwood Road.

This Agency has scheduled a roadway widening project on Redwood Road. Our construction activities will begin in the beginning of April 1996. In my recent telephone conversation with Scott Seery, (510) 567-6783, of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, it is my understanding that this well may be removed or relocated when the information required has been extracted from it. It is requested that you coordinate with Mr. Seery regarding this matter and the removal of the well prior to our construction activities in April 1996.

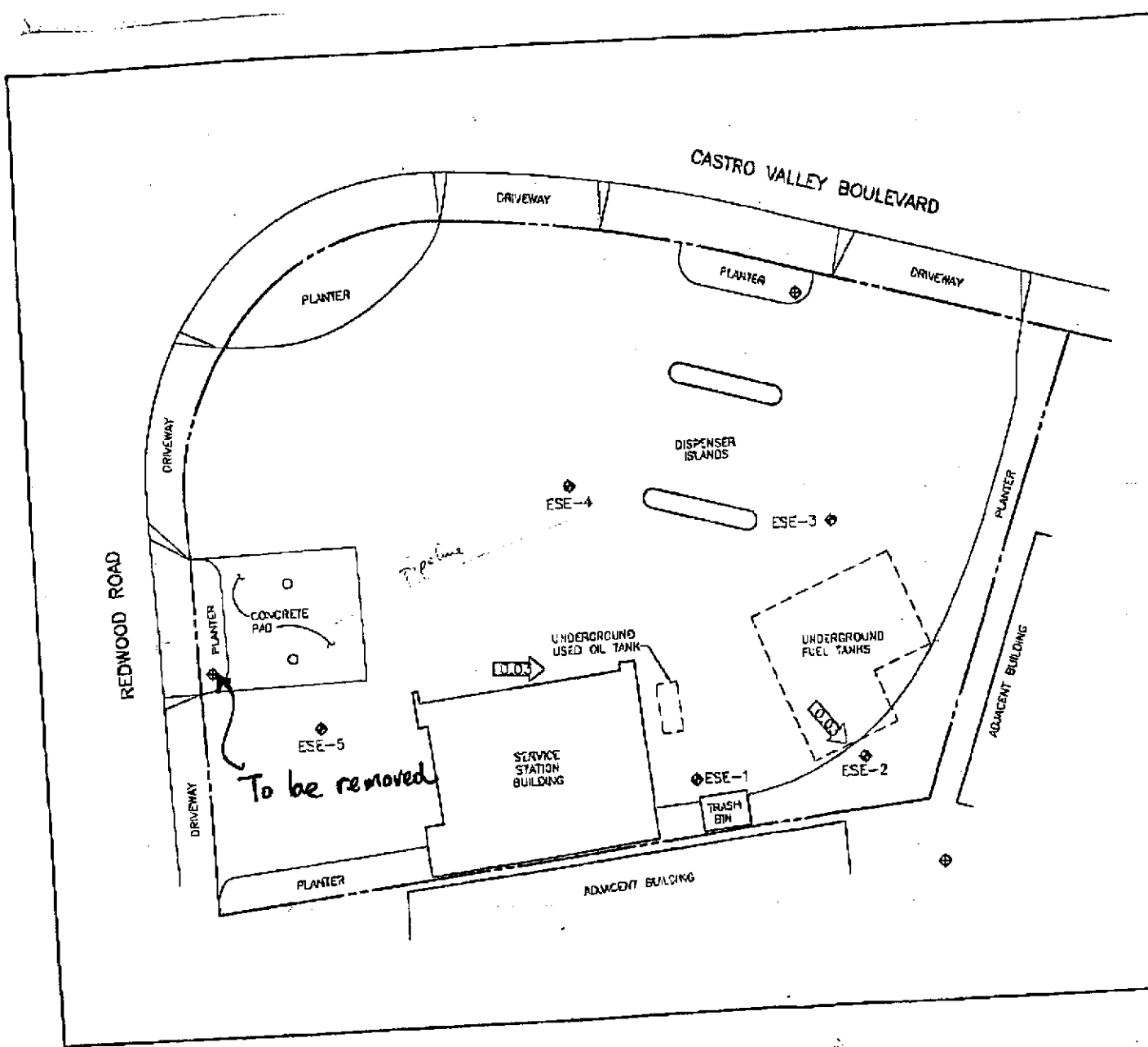

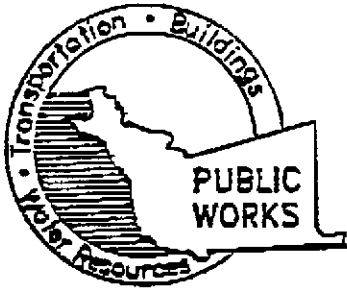


LEGEND
