MEMO to file:

Scott Hooten (BP Oil) and I spoke today. He inquired regarding what work the adjoining Xtra Oil site had undertaken. We discussed Xtra Oil's recent "hydropunch" study, and the ACDERT's request for permanent wells based on those results. We discussed that this phase of Xtra Oil's work was to focus on the off-site area south, SW, and east of ~~Xtra Oil's~~ site pending the results of BP Oil's further assessment of their site.

[REDACTED]. Mr. Hooten is also going to evaluate SVOCs using 8310 instead of 8270 (costs).

Finally, we debated whether or not GW encountered at the BP Oil site is under confined or unconfined conditions. He argued that only an aquifer test (pump test) would answer this. I argued that evaluation of boring logs and stabilized water levels will answer this question when considered in the

presence of well / water data from the other 30 odd sites in the C.V. Basin, which, for the most part, indicate confined to semi-confined conditions throughout the basin.

Mr. Hooten reported that BP and Xtra Oil have already begun to coordinate the sampling / monitoring schedules, but he has not been able to get Xtra Oil's information. I FAXed him excerpts from the recent hydro punch study and latest monitoring report, as well as the recent (May 18, 1994?) ACDEN request for off-site wells and CAP.
