Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), respectfully requests an extension to the Soil Vapor Investigation report for former Chevron Station 9-5607, which was located at 5269 Crow Canyon Road, Castro Valley, Alameda County, California. In a letter dated September 22, 2016, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requested a Soil Vapor Investigation report with a due date of December 2, 2014. On October 31, 2016, we requested an extension to December 16, 2016 due to more than 1-inch of rain in Castro Valley three days before our scheduled vapor sampling event per DTSC's soil gas investigation advisory.

CEMC respectfully requests an extension to January 16, 2017 to allow time to complete the necessary internal reviews of the data that have been impacted by the holiday schedule.
