I spoke w/ Mike Cooke (Weiss) today re: RBCA / SVS report for this site. I requested receipt of several references cited by Weiss in the report.

In addition, I discussed some of my initial concerns regarding the scope as it currently stands, as follows:

- 1) re duplicity of data - initial approach w.p. was to have two (2) rounds of soil vapor sampling to ~~evaluate~~ evaluate whether data are reproducible (i.e., identify any sampling QA/QC problems or seasonal variables which might influence sample results.)
- 2) Chevron's intent to use this site as a "model" to apply to other similar projects in future - even more reason to go "overboard" w/r data collection + validation
- 3) Natural and man-made preferential vapor pathways - apparently no or little effort was expended to evaluate presence of either; even though the Weiss/RWQCB draft flow chart indicates such is needed - other receptors may need to be identified

2/27/87

- 5) I would not be able to certify as to the validity of data or conclusions in the absence of proper application of items 1, 2, and 6.
- 6) Original scope of work required two (2) data collection events, as directed by RWQCB.
- 7) Weiss has only done one (1) project (Berkeley) where SVS data were corroborated w/ flux chamber data; Weiss has only done 3 projects using direct SVS measurements, one of which is this project and another is a still-pending Shell site in San Leandro.

I ask that he talk to Brett Hunter (Chevron) re these points, including a second limited round of data collection and evaluation of preferential vapor flow pathways.

I spoke with Chevron's Brett Hunter today regarding Chevron's bid to integrate an additional down-gradient well into the GW extraction system. I apologized that no one had responded to him in the past; this ~~one~~ aspect of the case had been referred to the RWQCB ~ 1½ years ago. I just recently realized that he was still awaiting a response before implementing his <sup>proposed</sup> design modifications.

I informed him of the 60 day "grace period" 23CCR ~~one~~ recognizes as appropriate from when a work plan is submitted to the LIA, to when the RP may implement it. I told him that, if in his professional opinion, and based on the desire and need to expand the capture zone of the current extraction system, his proposed modifications would appease both fronts, then he should go ahead and implement it.

I asked that he review the aquifer test and modeling data to see if his opinion is the same today, and that he should just write a short letter explaining the plan, ~~and~~ add to reference our telephone conversation today.
