Hi Dilan,

In accordance with a letter from Jerry Wickham dated 1/20/16, I am providing to you the status of restarting the SVE system for RO 357 Snow Cleaners at 2678 Coolidge Avenue in Oakland.

As I had indicated on the telephone previously, we are still waiting for the chiller to arrive and be installed prior to starting the SVE system for the subject case. The chiller is required to reduce the extracted vapor concentrations to allow compliance with the BAAQMD SVE system permit. I am expecting to find out the status of the SVE system startup by the end of 2/24/16 and will let you know once I get the information.

We started the groundwater treatment system last week but had to shut it down based on precipitation, in accordance with our EBMUD discharge permit conditions. When we re-started the system on Monday 2/22/16 the controller for the pump was determined to require replacement. I am presently expecting the replacement pump controller to arrive by the end of this coming Thursday 2/25/16, and we are presently scheduled to install the replacement pump controller and restart the groundwater extraction system this coming Friday 2/26/16.

I will let you know once the groundwater extraction system is restarted.
