At the request of Exxon Company, U.S.A. (Exxon), Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) is notifying you of the upcoming fieldwork related to the performance of a soil and groundwater investigation at the subject site. **The work is scheduled to begin on March 29, 2000.** The purpose of the investigation is to evaluate groundwater conditions downgradient of the site.

Work will include drilling and collecting samples from two Geoprobe® soil borings in Telegraph Avenue. The work will take approximately one day. The work will be performed in accordance with ERI's Work Plan for Soil and Groundwater Investigation (January 4, 2000). The proposed Geoprobe® locations are shown on the attached Generalized Site Plan (Plate 1).

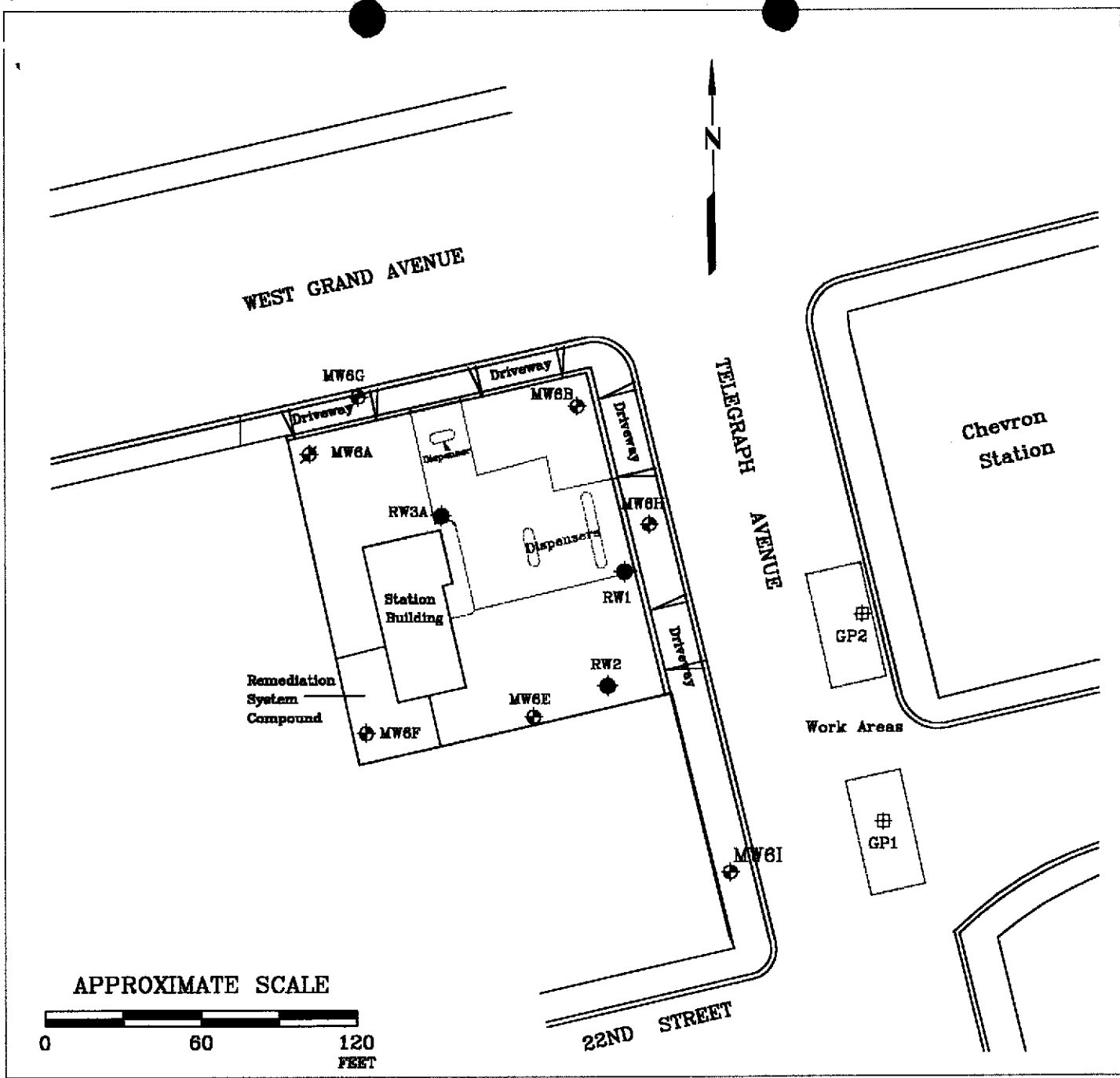
