Mr. Truong:

At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Services (EMES), on behalf of Exxon Mobil Corporation, Cardno ERI is notifying you of a high-intensity targeted (HIT) event to be performed at the subject site. The HIT event will be conducted for approximately two weeks. Testing equipment is scheduled to arrive on site on July 28, 2014. Testing will occur from July 28 through August 8, 2014. Wells MW6B, MW6H, MW6Ka, MW6Kb, MW6La, and MW6Lb will be used during this event. Well locations are illustrated on the attached Generalized Site Plan.

During testing activities, a mobile remediation system and generator will be operated at the site. Extracted groundwater from testing activities will be placed in a separate water storage trailer and stored at the site. One driveway along West Grand Avenue will be closed during remedial activities (see attached map). Testing equipment, including the water storage trailer, is tentatively scheduled for removal on August 8, 2014.

Cardno ERI appreciates your cooperation in ensuring that field work occurs safely and efficiently. Cardno ERI will minimize disruptions to station operations while on site.
