Memo to file:

I spoke w/ Brett Hunter (Charron) on 3/10/00 regarding pending well installations. We distinguished between wells intended to define MCBE plume dimensions vs. wells for HC plume and RBCA evaluations.

Charron (or their consultant) will take a look @ ~~maximum~~, historic concentrations of EOC in samples collected in wells at the site, and compare these levels to RBCA screening levels (RBSL). If concentrations are below such values, perhaps the need to encroach onto the adjoining hotel property (in lieu of installing a MW-3 replacement well where proposed) is mute. Specifically, the HC plume would, therefore, be defined to the south and SE by well MW-10.

The MCBE plume, as currently mapped, appears to potentially be more elongated than the HC plume. The wells recently requested for completion on the opposite side of Foothill way, therefore, be adequate at this point to define the MCBE plume. Consequently, wells on the adjacent hotel property may not be necessary for the purpose of MCBE definition.

Charron (or their consultant) will package a response to these issues.
