I spoke today w/ Mr. Chopra re: his schedule for new tank installation and our desire for contaminated soil to be removed to the extent possible before setting new tanks. I directed Mr. Chopra to the 10-19-95 correspondence from this office which requested this action, and, in fact, asked that this task be incorporated into the CAP.

Mr. Chopra's consultant (Paul King / Amad - P+D) informed me that free gasoline was observed in soil below the northern-most dispenser, and that other areas of the UST pit were "hot." It is prudent, therefore, to remove these source areas now that they are exposed and the equipment to do so is mobilized at the site.

I informed Mike Bakaldin (SLFD) of this today.
