Hello Kit,

This is a summary of our meeting notes and action items:

The source of the SPH needs to be evaluated prior to risking away soil gas concentrations. AECOM will research historical documents and do a data evaluation.

Develop soil gas plume maps.

Collect soil gas samples from SVG nested soil probes to get current site conditions.

You mentioned a list of 3<sup>rd</sup> party toxicologists ACEH would forward. I looked into GeoSyntec Consultants and they have provided support as a 3<sup>rd</sup> party reviewer for the Orange County Local Oversight Program and Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board. Also, they have provided this support for the City of Huntington Beach.
