Ninyo & Moore has prepared this Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Addendum for the Bill Chun Service Station site located at 2301 Santa Clara Avenue in Alameda, California. This CAP Addendum has been prepared to address technical comments from Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) received in a directive letter dated February 11, 2014 relating to the locations of proposed extraction wells EW-21 and EW-22. The technical comments included the following:

- ACEH requested that the proposed extraction wells EW-21 and EW-22 should be moved from their current proposed locations to locations nearer the boundary of the benzene plume to avoid potentially causing expansion of the benzene plume beyond its current extent.
- ACEH requested that the proposed extraction well EW-21 be moved to a location near existing well MW-12 and proposed extraction well EW-22 be moved to a location near existing well MW-11R.

The attached Figure 1 shows the new locations for proposed extraction wells EW-21 and EW-22 in relation to the benzene plume. Proposed extraction well EW-21 was moved approximately 40 feet southwest from its former planned location to the new location near existing well MW-12. Proposed extraction well EW-22 was moved approximately 70 feet north-northwest from its former planned location to the new location near existing well MW-11R.
