Mr. Calica,

A plume of contaminated groundwater extends from the Bill Chun service station site beneath the Flower shop property at 2305 Santa Clara Avenue. Therefore, a potential for vapor intrusion from groundwater to indoor air does exist. Due to the potential for vapor intrusion to indoor air, sub-slab and indoor air sampling at adjacent properties was conducted at the site in November 2012. The results are presented in a Site Investigation Report dated December 26, 2012 that can be viewed on the Alameda County Environmental Health website noted below.

A Corrective Action Plan for site remediation has been completed and will undergo a public comment period. Site cleanup is expected to begin within the next few months and will extend over a period of months to years.

Tried to get a hold of you...we keep missing each other.

I'm interested in leasing the Flower shop that is right next to the service station. My business is basically people playing games for a few hours at a time, including a fair number of kids. I need to figure out if there are vapors from the clean up site coming through the building that could put people at risk. In looking at the reports online for the well data, it appears that the site was on a good path to being decontaminated until 2012, and suddenly there was a significant spike in a number of the bad chemicals.

Two questions:

1) is there any reason that you know of or can think of for those numbers to jump suddenly in 2012?

2) Is there any tests that can be done to see if there are vapors coming into the building from the site? (the address of the flower shop is 2305 Santa Clara.

Actually, the third question would be what is currently being done with the site and what needs to be done either to complete the decontamination, or to make sure that the contamination does not affect the building next door?
