Hi Jerry,

I am working on completing the 2nd Quarter 2015 monitoring report now and will address your technical comments in that report.

I think I should have provided some more discussion about the overall system flow rate in the CAP and initial report. The startup overall system flow rate of 1 gpm was established to make sure the system was running well and injection water wasn't surfacing at any of the injection points. The rate of 2 to 3 gpm is the design rate specified in the CAP and was established based on aquifer testing. The overall system flow rate was increased on May 8 and May 15. Since then the system has been running between 1.8 and 2.9 gpm.

Since the overall system flow rate was increased it looks like we have established good control of the plume. Primarily because concentrations in MW-14 dropped significantly and groundwater contours show steep gradients to the north-northeast and southwest, toward the extraction wells EW-20, EW-21, and EW-22.
