Thank you for arranging your schedule to meet on Oct. 10, 2011 at the City of Alameda Economic Development Department to discuss the contents of the September 8, 2011 letter regarding Bill Chun Service Station.

Since I am not familiar with reports or projects with the property, your help in responding to questions about the technical comments, language and processes stated in the letter is helpful to bring awareness of some of the issues to me. The due dates for a new consultant, well inspection and groundwater sampling work plan and a draft corrective action plan were also part of the discussion. Donna Drogos provided San Mateo County as a source for a list of consultants.

The San Mateo County list of consultants is extensive. It appears that finding a new, professional licensed consultant (and per your letter, "not associated with the current consultant") will take research and time to interview many who fit this criteria. As trustee, I must do due diligence in regards to all business with the trust.

I am requesting an extension of the due date of the Well Inspection and Groundwater Sampling Work Plan to January 31, 2012 and a postponement of the Draft Corrective Action Plan to a date to be determined after your review of and response to the work plan.
