Dear Ms. Eberle:

Enclosed is the quarterly report which summarizes the groundwater monitoring and vapor extraction activities conducted at the Safety-Kleen Service Center located at 400 Market Street in Oakland, California. This report covers the period from March through May 1994. Also included is information regarding the product recovery system installed in January 1993.

Based on the extensive database of groundwater analytical results which have been obtained throughout the life of this project, Safety-Kleen will be modifying the groundwater sampling schedule starting with the quarterly event in July 1994. The new schedule will reduce the sampling of selected wells to a semi-annual or an annual basis. The modified sampling schedule is as follows:
