At the request of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation (ExxonMobil), Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) is notifying you of the upcoming field work related to the subject site. Work will include installing four on-site dual-phase extraction (DPE) wells (DPE1 through DPE4) as part of a soil and groundwater remediation system to be installed at the site in June 2003. Well locations are shown on the attached Generalized Site Plan. Drilling is scheduled for June 4 and 5, 2003. ERI anticipates the work will be completed in two days.


